



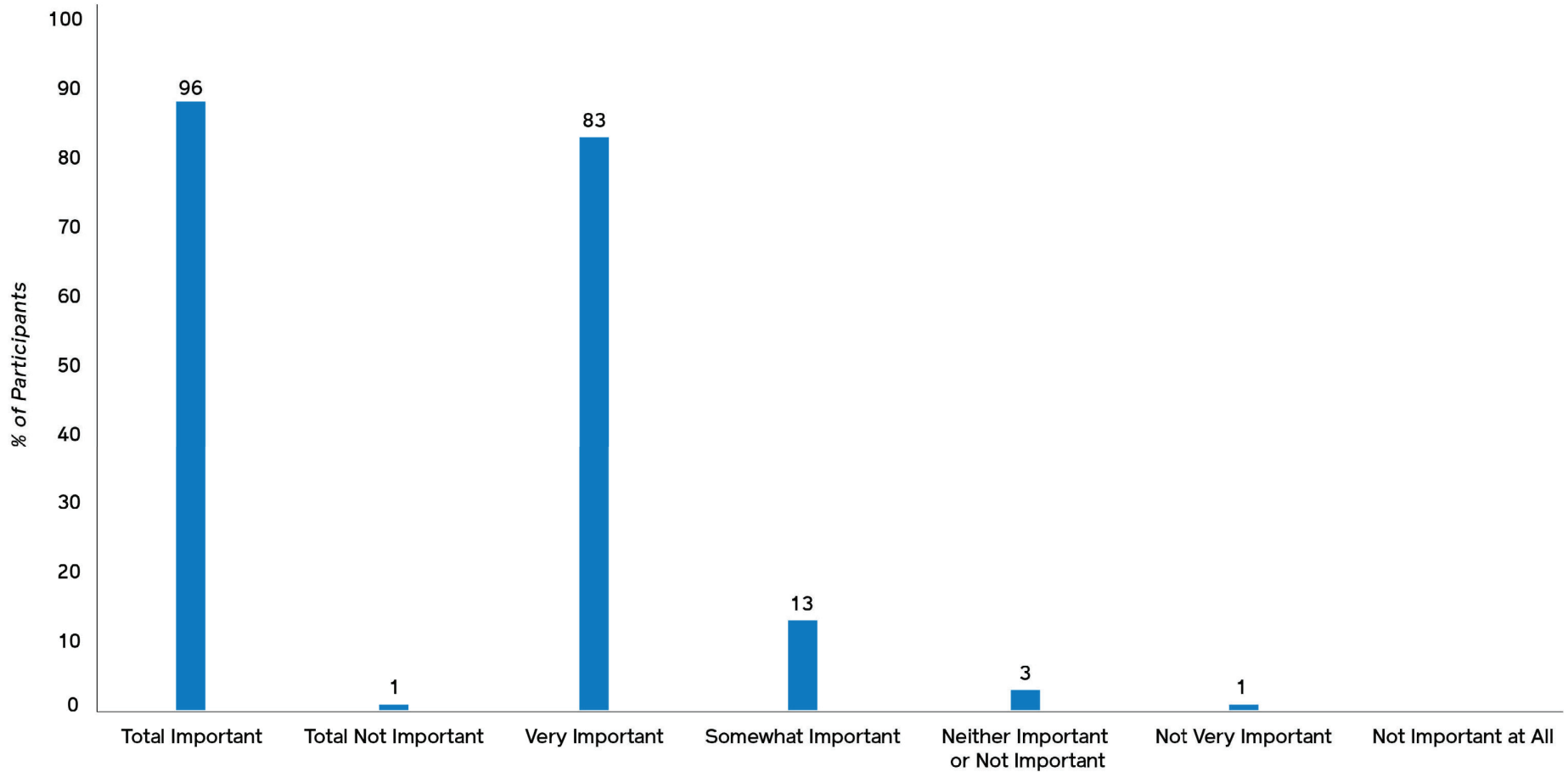
ONLINE CHILD SAFETY POLL

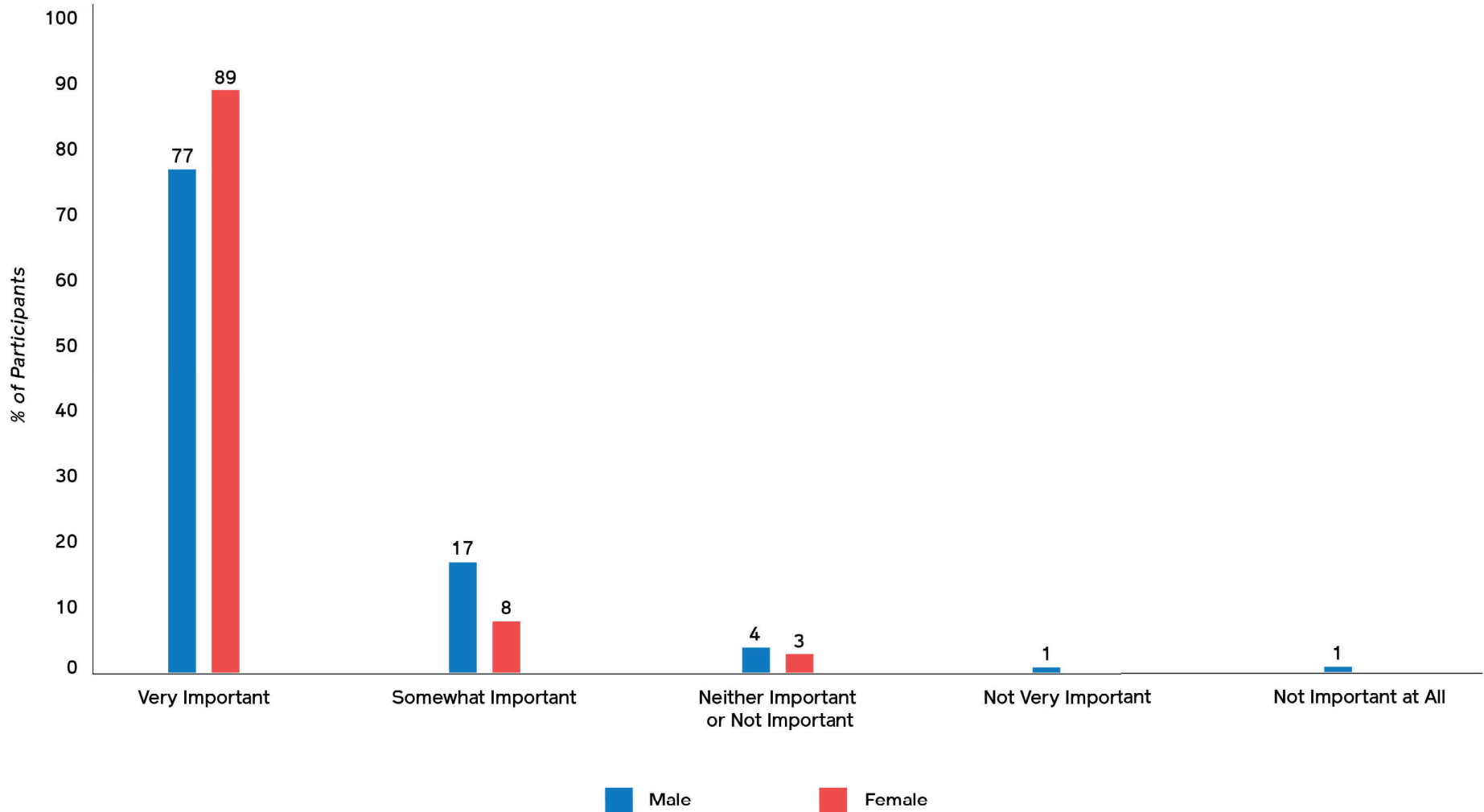

Data representative of total participants



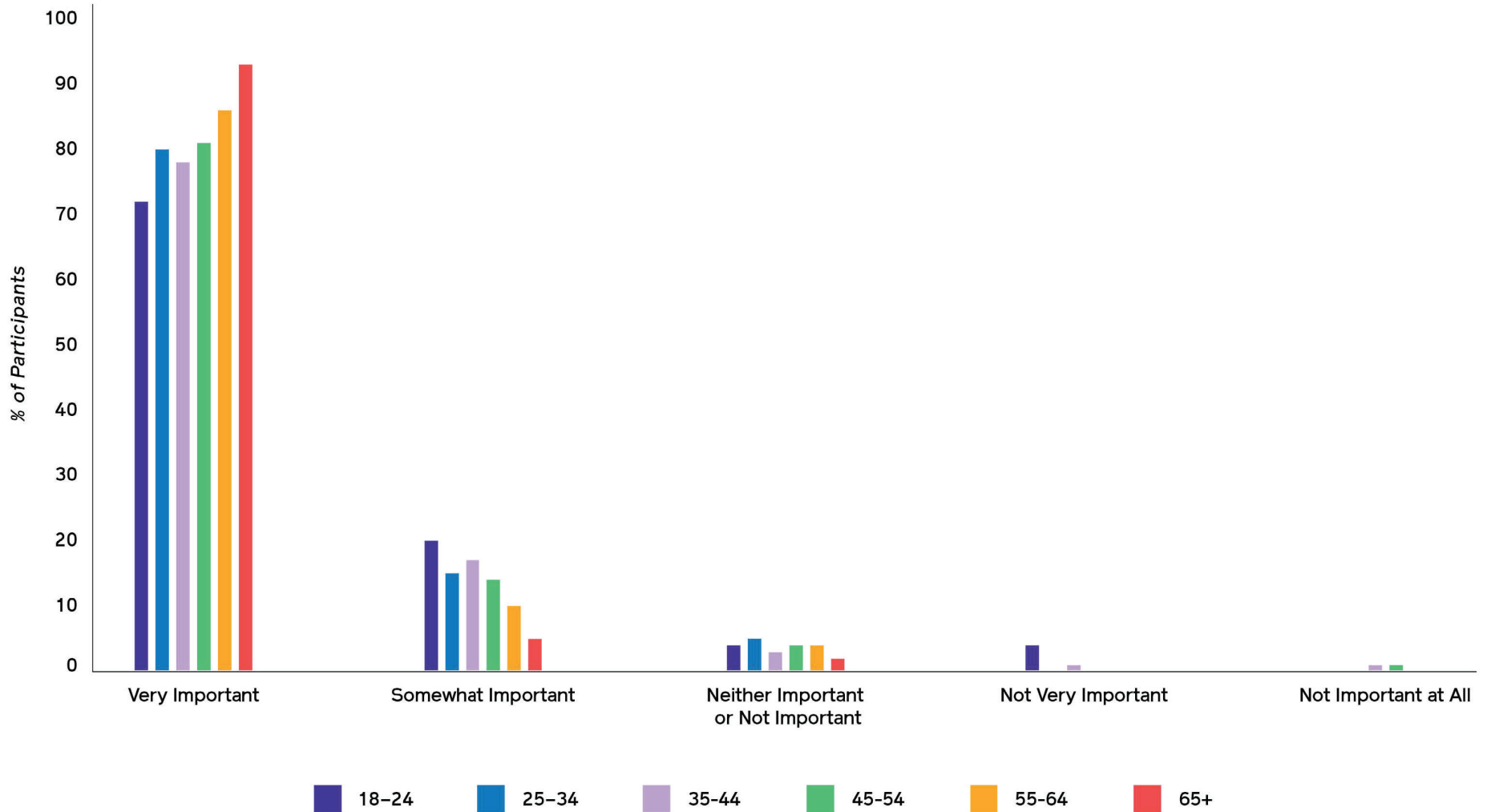

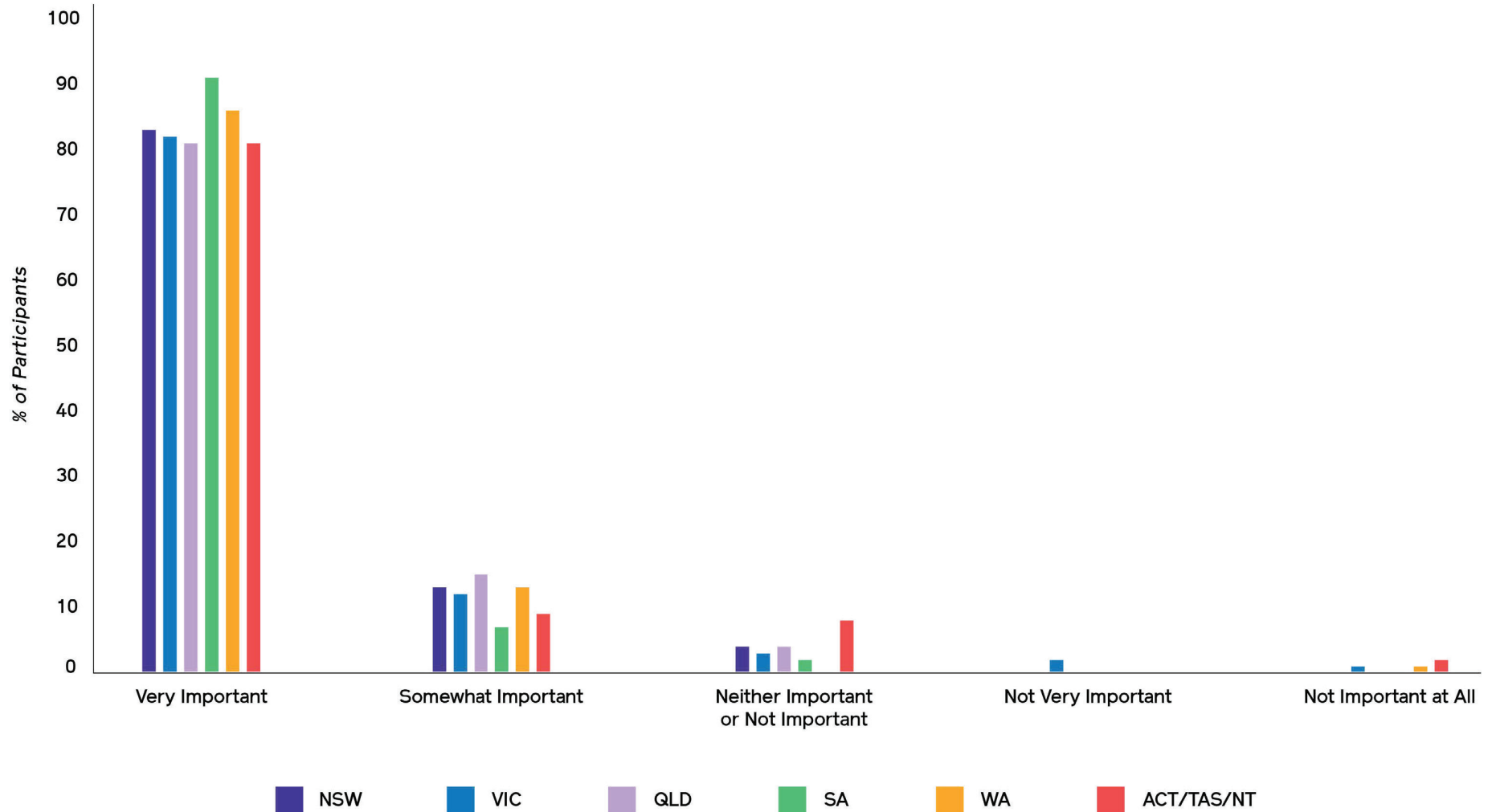

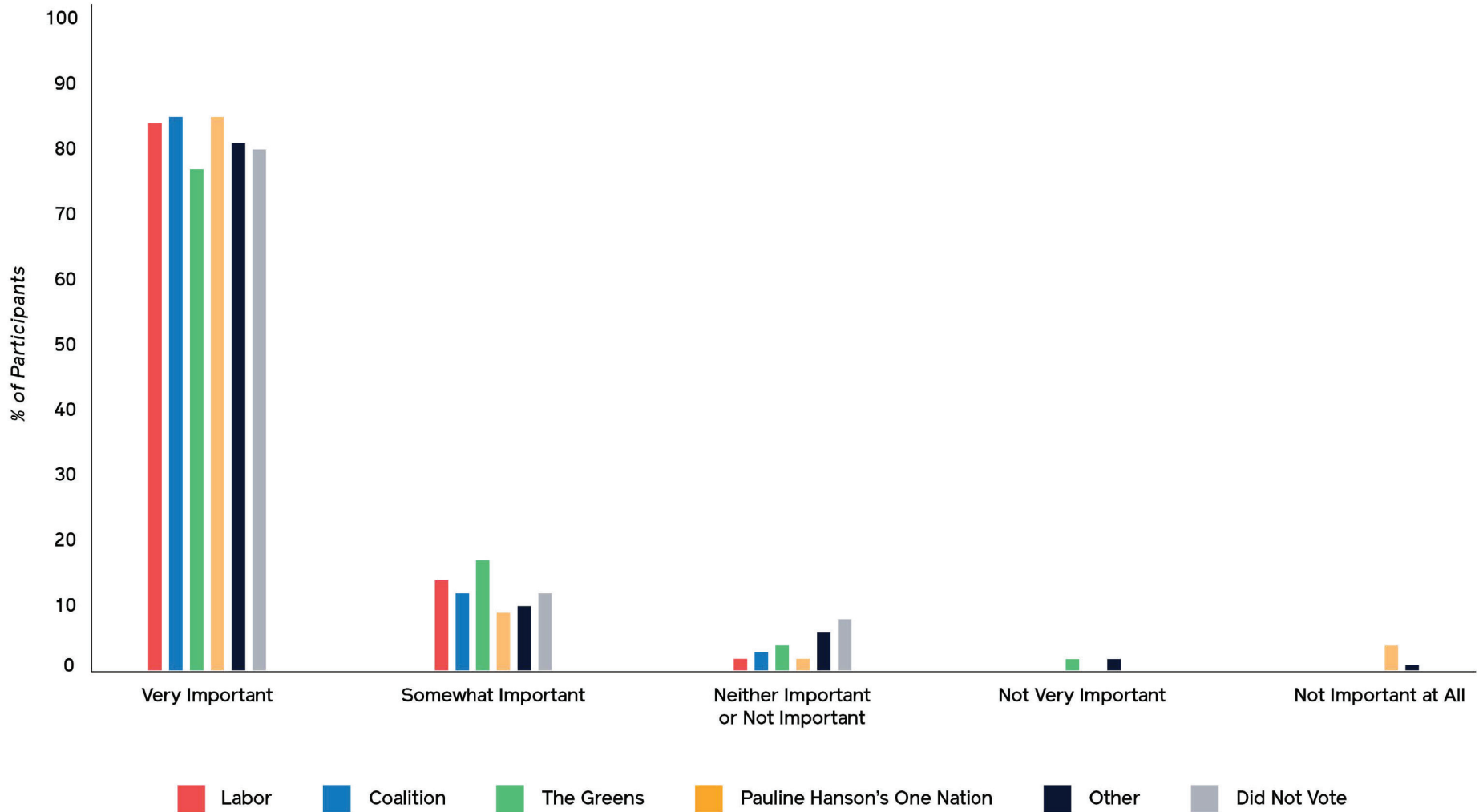
